#### Information Campaign “Countdown to 1 Year of LOK”, marking one year of the LOK

##### Countdown to 1 Year of LOK

From 10 to 24 December 2025, the Curaçao Gaming Authority (CGA) will launch a special information socialmedia campaign: the “Countdown to 1 Year of LOK.”

Each day leading up to 24 December, CGA will publish a short message explaining a key element of the new gambling legislation, the LOK, and what it means for Curaçao, for operators, and for players.

##### Why this campaign?

With the introduction of the LOK, Curaçao has taken an important step toward a modern regulatory framework for games of chance. At the same time, there are still many questions and misunderstandings within both the local and international communities.

Through the “Countdown to 1 Year of LOK,” CGA aims to:

- Increase clarity and trust in the LOK and in CGA’s supervisory role.
- Show how the LOK helps protect players, prevent money laundering, and support the local economy.
- Address doubts and myths that continue to circulate about the LOK.
- Celebrate one year of the LOK together with partners and the gaming community.

##### How will the campaign work?

Each day from 10 to 24 December 2025, CGA will share short, easy-to-read and easy-to-share content such as infographics, simplified Q&As, timeline elements from the LOK process, or a special video.

CGA invites everyone to follow its official channels to learn more about gaming regulation and supervision, so that:

- players and consumers can participate in gaming in a safer way.
- operators and license holders can use the information to better align with the new rules and strengthen their own compliance.
- and local and international partners can engage in dialogue about building a safer and more responsible gaming sector for Curaçao.

##### Calling on the community

The Curaçao Gaming Authority calls on the community for their attention and cooperation during the “Countdown to 1 Year of LOK” campaign, both to celebrate one year of the LOK and to continue building a gaming sector that is safe, secure, transparent, and beneficial for the people of Curaçao.
